PONTIFICAL RITE OF BAPTISM FOR INFANTS Checklist

PERMISSIONS

- o Ensure all required permissions have been granted for ritual §
- o Ensure all required permissions have been granted for sponsors[†]

VESTMENTS

- o Rochet, Amice, Alb, Cincture
- o Purple Cope and Stole
- o Gold/White Cope and Stole
- o Gold Mitre
- o Precious Mitre
- o Gremial

ATTENDANTS

- o Master of Ceremonies (can be combined with priest attendant if absolutely needed)
- o Priest attendant 1
- o Priest attendant 2
- o Holding the Ritual Book
- o Holding the Mitre
- o Holding the Crozier
- o Holding the Bugia
- o Moving the Faldstool

SUPPLIES

- o Bishop's Bugia
- o Bishop's Crozier
- o Bishop's Faldstool
- o Bishop's Ewer and Basin
- o Water (already blessed or to be blessed in the Ewer)
- o Salt (already blessed or to be blessed)
- o Holy Oil
- o Sacred Chrism
- o Vimpae
- o Cotton or like material (*for wiping the anointed parts*)
- o Tray or vessel for receiving the cotton
- o Bread (to remove oil from the fingers could also be cotton or similar from above)
- o Basin for use when wash afterwards, not to be used for other purposes
- o White baptismal garment
- o Baptismal candle

§ If the priest performing the baptism is **not** the **pastor** of the **parish** where the baptism will be performed, he must (per Summorum Pontificum and Universae Ecclesiae) receive permission from the pastor both to perform the baptism and also to use blessings or ceremonies from the Rituale Romanum. If the priest is **neither** the **pastor** nor **associate** of the **parish** where the baptism will be performed, he must also request permission to celebrate the baptism in general, unrelated to the form (per Canon 862). If a bishop performs the baptism **in** his **cathedral** or **in another parish** in **his diocese**, no such permissions are required from the pastor. If a bishop performs the baptism in a parish **in** a **different diocese**, these permissions are required from the pastor.

† If the sponsors are members of a parish different than where the baptism is performed, they need to present a letter from their pastor saying that they are practicing Catholics, registered members to their home parish, and they have their pastor's permission to be sponsors.
